Example of a prompt:

Audience: Our resellers, such as tour operators, OTAs, online marketplaces, and DMCs.

Writing style:

- Clear, concise and engaging
- Friendly, conversational, yet professional
- Easy to understand for non-native English speakers
- Use British English spelling, grammar and expressions
- Avoid hype, jargon or AI-style phrasing

- Remember, that you can also ask the AI tool to ask you questions if something isn't clear.
